

Allegheny Snowmobile Trails, PA

Trail Location: Allegheny National Forest

Trail Length: 159 miles

Counties: Elk; Forest; Mc Kean; Warren

Nearby Towns: Bradford, Warren, Sheffield, Kane, Marienville, Kellettsville

Activities:

Walking, Horseback Riding, Snowmobiles, Mountain Biking, hunter access

Trail Surface(s):

Gravel, Dirt

Trail Description:

This trail is in excess of 300 miles (including snowmobile trail connectors). There are 3 trail host houses located along the trail system for serving the snowmobilers. Much of this trail is located on roads that are open in summer and snow covered in winter. The trail is marked with orange diamonds.

Parking & Trail Access:

Marienville and Kane have easy access to the trail system. Brown Run Road (off of SR 59, just east of Warren) also has trail access.

Seasonal Restrictions:

Snowmobile season runs from December 20-April 1 each year. Trail is open to the other uses listed above during off season.
