

Betzwood Trail

Multi-Use Trail System

Located in the Valley Forge National Park, there are many interesting and beautiful sites along this trail. The first and most impressive view you will have is that of the Schuylkill River. Most of the trail runs along the edge of the river, offering spectacular scenery and wildlife. **Betzwood Trail is a 12-mile straight, flat trail that leads to Valley Forge.** The trail is largely under tree cover.

In addition to serving as a hiking trail, the **three-mile South trail** is also designated as a horseback trail.

In almost any outdoor activity, there is some risk. Remember to be alert and careful when using the trail. "911" phones are provided for emergency use only. You will notice mileage markers on the trail. They are there for your use when reporting emergencies and to gauge your mileage use.

Milepost "0" is at the Betzwood entrance to the Valley Forge National Historical Park (VF).
