

Forks Township Recreation Trail, PA

Trail Location: Forks Township to Palmer Townships

Trail Length: 7 miles

Counties: Northampton

Activities:

Walking, Horseback Riding, Biking, In-line Skating, Mountain Biking, Wheelchair Accessible

Trail Surface(s):

Asphalt, Gravel

Trail Description:

This is a quiet, agreeable trail passing through corn fields, and woodlands. It meanders past old stone fencing and rocky outcrops and passes high above the Delaware River.

Parking & Trail Access:

Take Exit 6 (13th Street) from Route 22 in Easton and turn left at the stoplight onto 13th Street. At the next traffic light (Bushkill Drive) turn left. After three miles, turn right onto Newlins Road West and then left at Sullivan Trail. Make a quick right run back onto Newlins Road West. At the intersection with Broadway, turn right and follow Broadway .2 miles to the trailhead.
